Thank you for this consultation.

Having looked at the proposals I don't think there is any need to change our earlier advice on the previous version of the application. The outbuilding appears to be a late 19th C addition to the property and the proposed alterations will not significantly impact the ability to "read" the building (for example there is a blocked door onto the road which will still be obvious even with the proposed rebuilding of a large section of the wall) and so I do not think there is any need for archaeological recording.
