### **Further Information**

Lancashire County Council acting as the Local Highway Authority does not consider that the application as submitted fully assesses the highway impact of the proposed development and further information is required as set out in this response. Without this information the Local Highway Authority is unable to provide final highway advice on this application.

### **Advice to Local Planning Authority**

The Local Highway Authority (LHA) are in receipt of an application for the proposed partial demolition of an existing stable building and the erection of a new stable building at the land to the rear of 2 Bramley View, Clitheroe Road, Whalley.

The LHA are aware that the site will continue to be accessed off a private, unadopted access track located off Clitheroe Road which is a C classified road subject to a 40mph speed limit.

The LHA have reviewed the supporting documents and require further information in the guise of a short statement, stating whether the proposal will be for domestic or commercial purposes.
