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Following consultation with members of the parish council the listed concerns and objections have been raised: -

- The barns are not old barns and are used for keeping cattle in over winter.
- There have been suspicions that someone is living on the site in a caravan.
- The location is almost on the top of the ridge of the hill and is visible in the landscape from distance.
- In recent times the barns have sprouted several radio masts which do not add to the scene.
- Statement 1.2 of the applicant's Planning Statement states that the proposed development is in Green Belt, the parish council object to green belt being built on.
- Allowing this could set a dangerous precedent and open the floodgates that could see old sheds and farm buildings throughout the parish being converted into large properties, no doubt for marketing purposes, at the expense of the local residents and area.
