



Dairy Barn Farm is in the Forest of Bowland AONB.

This extension to the farmhouse is designed to improve the access for farmworkers by providing a de-robing space as part of the farms' bio safety drive. Farm workers access will be separated from general visitors and householders access.

The design is kept simple replacing an existing lean-to structure with a more substantial lean-to with slate roof and rendered walls. The walls will include feature stone quoins, heads, jambs and cills. The roof will overhang to create a covered area to the garden.

Level access is provided to the main entrance with other level differences accommodated by providing dwarf retaining walls with stone copings. The family garden is secured by a 1.5m rendered wall replacing the existing fence.
