1 ASSESSMENT

- 1.1 In 1998, applications were made for Planning Permission, to rebuild an adjacent barn (now known as Parlick Cottage) as a detached self contained Holiday Let (application no: 3/98/0729) and a separate application was made to convert an existing adjacent garage/store into two semi-detached Holiday Lets (application no: 3/98/0728). Both applications were approved and the schemes implemented.
- 1.2 The existing Holiday Lets within the converted garage are now known as Jefferey and Pendle Cottages, and are attached to garaging owned by the adjacent property, Pale Farm Barn.
- 1.3 The development is situated at the end of a narrow country lane, known as Moss Lane, and was resurfaced when the development was originally carried out.
- 1.4 As Holiday Lets, the properties have been popular, and the applicant is keen to convert the property into a dwelling house, which will meets with the Local Authorities Housing Needs.
- 1.5 Prior to the conversion into Holiday Lets the single storey building had pebble dashed walls and profile metal clad roof, and as part of the previous application, the walls were clad in stone, with stone heads and cills, and the roof replaced with a slate roof on timber trusses, all to the requirements of the Building Regulations at the time of construction.
- 1.6 Existing landscaping is minimal with grassed areas and stone flagged patio areas to the rear, and there is a shared tarmac drive with 2no dedicated parking bays, and a further 2no for the adjacent Parlick Cottage.
- 1.7 The property is served by water and electricity, and a sewage treatment plant.

1 ASSESSMENT (Cont.)

- 1.8 The conversion of the Holiday Lets into a dwelling house, would address neighbours concerns about their transient neighbours, and would reduce traffic along Moss Lane.
- 1.9 We have recently submitted a planning application (3/2011/0249) for the removal of the condition to Parlick Cottage, which currently restricts its use as a Holiday Let. This application is still being processed.

2 INVOLVEMENT

- 2.1 We have made brief discussions with Graeme Thorpe, and he commented that it may be that this particular application will help remove the neighbours objection of 'conflict' between Parlick Cottage being converted into a house, with Jefferey and Pendle Cottages remain as existing Holiday Lets.
- 2.2 It is understood that there will be legal implications and costs in removing the Section 106 Agreements, should this and the other current applications are approved.

3 **EVALUATION**

- The applicant also owns the adjacent property, Parlick Cottage, currently a Holiday Let, 3.1 which is hoped to be granted Planning Approval to change its use to a dwelling house.
- 3.2 The conversion of Jefferey and Pendle Cottages will eliminate local concerns relating to 'conflict' between dwelling house and holiday lets.
- 3.3 Existing services, parking areas and boundary treatments remain as existing.
- 3.4 The majority of the alterations are internal, with the alteration of 3no rear window openings which are to be altered into door openings.

4 DESIGN

- 4.1 Majority of the alteration works to convert the property into one dwelling, is internal.
- 4.2 The proposed works include altering 3no rear window openings into external door openings to take advantage of the views.
- 4.3 External works will remain as existing.
- There is adequate flagged areas to the rear to accommodate refuse and recycling bins.

 Collection will be by the Local Authority as existing.
- 4.5 The stone surround to the doorway is to remain, and a new stone jamb built in to the other side of the new opening.

5 ACCESS

- 5.1 The property is accessed via Moss Lane, which is a tarmac country lane, which was resurfaced at the time of the original development.
- 6.2 There are existing parking bays on site accessed via a tarmac drive
- 6.3 Access into and within the property will meet with the requirements of Part M of the Building Regulations at the time of construction
