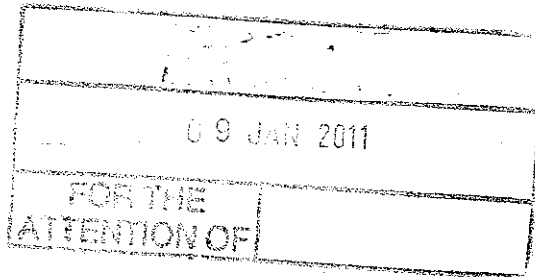

**Planning Application, Ribble Valley District
3/11/0909 22 Waddow Grove, Waddington**

I refer to your letter of 6 December 2011 concerning the above application.

I have no objection to the application in principle on highway safety grounds.

The design of the access to the proposed development retains the unimpeded operation of the existing turning head while securing suitable off street parking provisions to the property.

The creation of the new access will require the provision of an additional drop kerb and associated alterations to the existing footway. Accordingly, the following Conditions should be included in any consent:-

1. The kerbing at the vehicular crossing shall be reinstated in accordance with the Lancashire County Council Specification for Construction of Estate Roads, concurrent with the formation of the improved access. This is to provide the necessary access and to maintain the proper construction of the highway.
2. This consent requires the construction, improvement or alteration of an access to the public highway. Under the Highways Act 1980 Section 184 the County Council as Highway Authority must specify the works to be carried out. Only the Highway Authority or a contractor approved by the Highway Authority can carry out these works and therefore before any access works can start you must contact the Environment Directorate for further information, details below:
