DESIGN & ACCESS STATEMENT -- 16 CHURCH CLOSE, WADDINGTON

31 OCTOBER 2011

Design: The application property is located on Church Close, Waddington, this being a cul-de-sac development dating from the early 1970's of private individual houses, most being bungalows with large roofspaces. Access to the roofspace of no 16 is via a loft ladder.

The proposal is to remove the existing roof, the tiles of which are at the end of their useful life, and raise the ridge level by c. 1200mm, providing a complete new roof structure. First floor accommodation can then be provided to form a master bedroom with ensuite bathroom, and a small gym.

A new porch replacing the existing slightly smaller porch (with poor aluminium sliding door and structure) is to be provided, together with a new garden room/dining at the rear of the property; some internal alterations are proposed.

NB it should be noted that this planning application is very similar to that undertaken to no 19 Church Close (three properties away) in 2010 and for which planning consent was given.

Use: Existing private dwelling requiring refurbishment and extensions.

Amount: The porch extension is 1350 x 2250 o/a and with ridge at c. 3450 above ground level; the garden room extension is 5750 x 4200 o/a and with ridge at 4350 above gd. level.

Scale: The proposed new raised roof has been kept to a practicable minimum and is exactly similar to no 19 Church Close. The garden room which is not overlooked by other properties, has been kept again to a practicable minimum the width being dictated by the existing bedroom window and corner of the bungalow.

Landscaping: not applicable.

Access: Existing vehicular and pedestrian access are not affected. It should be noted that the garage is located in the north east corner of the site, being accessed from the 'spine road/cul de sac. and there is very adequate forecourt parking also.

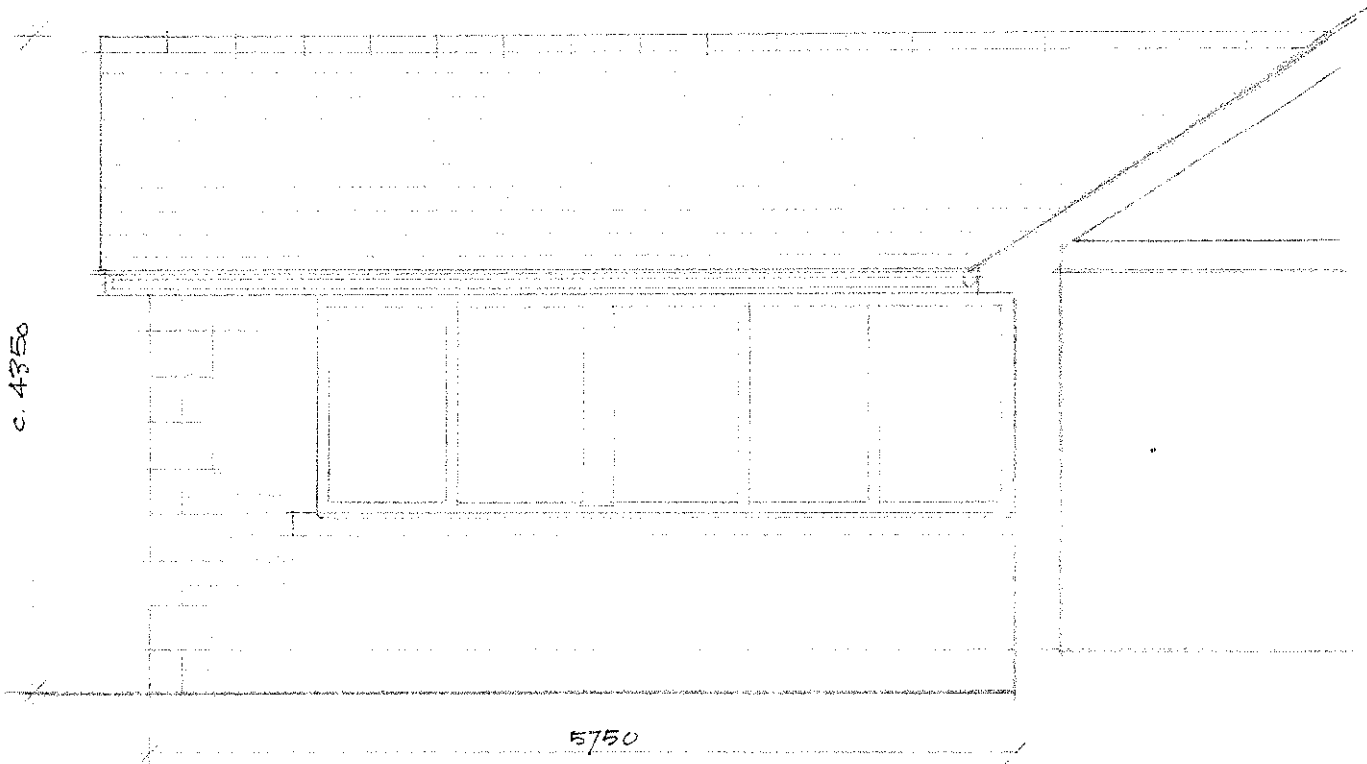
