Planning Application: 3/2012/0277
Location: Clitheroe Royal Grammar School,
 Chatburn Road, Clitheroe, BB7 2BA
Development: Erection of a new sports hall and re-orientation of existing tennis courts.

In addition to previous comments from this department a consideration of the effects of the proposed development on neighbouring properties has been made in relation to noise and light.

Apart from construction noise on which comments have already been made it is not felt that the development will cause any addition noise to surrounding residents. The activities within the sports hall can already be carried out in the open and the structure of the building will act as additional mitigation to the noise of children from within the site, thus reducing the noise level potentially already experienced by residents. The location of the new tennis courts is currently being used as a school field and again no increase in noise levels is expected.

The proposal does not include any additional external light that is likely to be a problem to neighbouring properties.
