On visiting the site I did note that visibility at the site access is restricted looking east along Garstang Road towards Chipping, although due to the layout of the road at this point traffic speeds are low. Whilst this does not justify a specific planning condition I have contacted the applicant's agent to recommend they investigate the possibility of making some modest improvements to the visibility splay by replacing a short length of the existing frontage hedge with fencing or replanting back from the carriageway edge.
