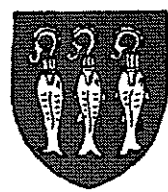

MB 3/2012/0618 Proposal: Single storey extension

Clearly the proposed extension exceeds the building line by some 2 metres thereby intruding onto the adjacent property.

### OBJECTION

The parish council will support any objection forwarded by RVBC, LCC officers, or any statutory consulters on the following issues.

- a. Education –The lack of places in Whalley and the Ribble Valley schools is the norm for both primary and secondary pupils. The resultant transport of pupils out of the area is financially and environmentally flawed. The parish council is strongly opposed to the education of local pupils away from the local community as appears the likely outcome of this proposed development
- b. Traffic– The parish council is strongly of the opinion that it is not appropriate to add to the traffic using Clitheroe Road and the attendant negative impact to Whalley centre.

- c. Existing policy - This proposal is deemed to be a small scale development which spuriously suggests that it attunes to Policies G4 and G5 of the Ribble Valley Local Plan. A feature of the last two years has been the succession of developers who wish to build both in the immediate environment of Whalley or within the parishes bordering the village (Billington/Barrow). Should all these proposed ribbon developments be successful the ACCUMALITIVE IMPACT will quickly destroy the ambience associated with a Ribble Valley Policy ENV3 recognises the need to protect and enhance open countryside, protect and conserve natural habitat and traditional landscape features This development destroys these features


