

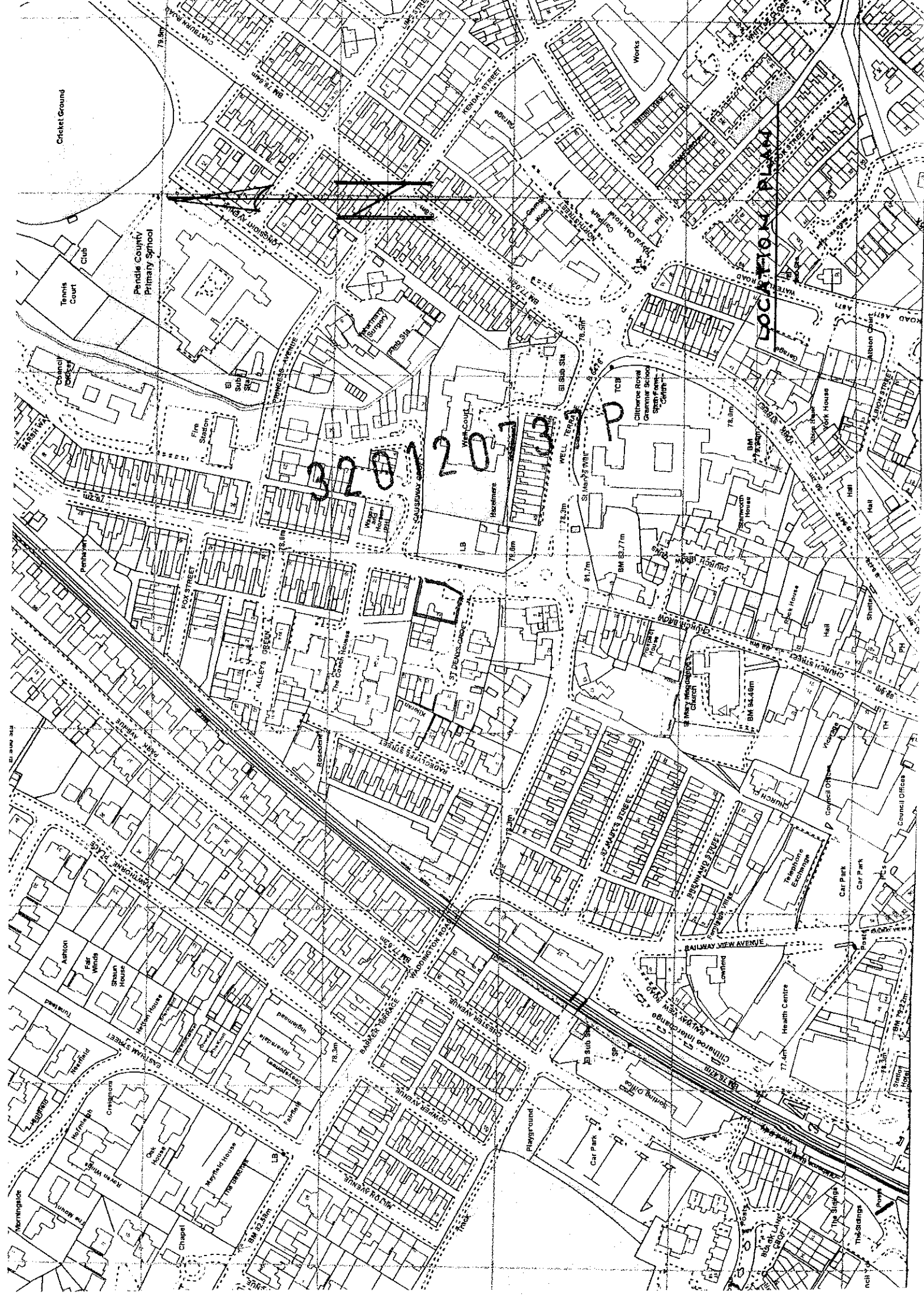

LOCATION

The property is the corner plot entering St Denys Croft with vehicular access and front elevation from the south. The side elevation and garden facing east along Pimlico Road.

The east boundary is staggered and is separated from the public footpath by a 900mm high mature stone wall with similar varying levels. The footpath is further separated from the road by a partial raised grass verge and two mature trees.

The east side garden is separated by a 1.80m high timber fence forming parking from the south and enclosed garden to the remainder with a 13.0m frontage to the highway. It is this boundary line that relates to this application.

ASSESSMENT

Prior to the erection of the new fence protection and privacy was formed by Leylandi trees forming a hedge with an 800mm high timber fence in front of the trees against the stone boundary wall.

The timber fence had become vandalised on a regular basis exposing the base of the trees and general privacy to the garden.

The exposed nature of the boundary protection becoming a haven for general litter discarding including chip trays, beer cans and bottles etc, on a regular basis becoming an attraction as a dumping ground by passer bys.

In mitigation the applicant had the existing hedge removed and replaced with the timber fence as detailed on Drawing No 4007.

The fence is set back and does not impair visibility site lines by virtue of the two mature trees when entering and departing St Denys Croft.

PROPOSALS

The fence is 1.90m high from the garden level which is within permitted heights, provides protection and privacy to the garden.

To improve the visible impact of the fence two coats of Cuprinol green stain shall be applied to both sides.

Under the circumstances in retrospect we proposed the fence should remain.
