Afternoon Mark.

I have now had the opportunity to have a look at the application site. The proposal is to increase the number of dwelling at the site brought about by the conversion of 3 barns to 4 dwellings. The proposal has the potential to increase the level of traffic entering /leaving the site which in itself will generate conflict between opposing vehicles entering /leaving the site. Whilst I previously mentioned that this could be addressed by altering the junction, having visited the site it is clear that the sight lines , particularly to the left, are substandard and will require substantial earthworks to remedy. Due to this I would have to recommend refusal on the grounds that the increased traffic would be using a substandard junction to the detriment of the safety of road users.

There may be merit in considering the relocation of the access further north. This would not achieve the necessary sightlines but it would be a significant benefit over the current access and may, subject to design, offer sufficient mitigation to reconsider my recommendation for refusal
