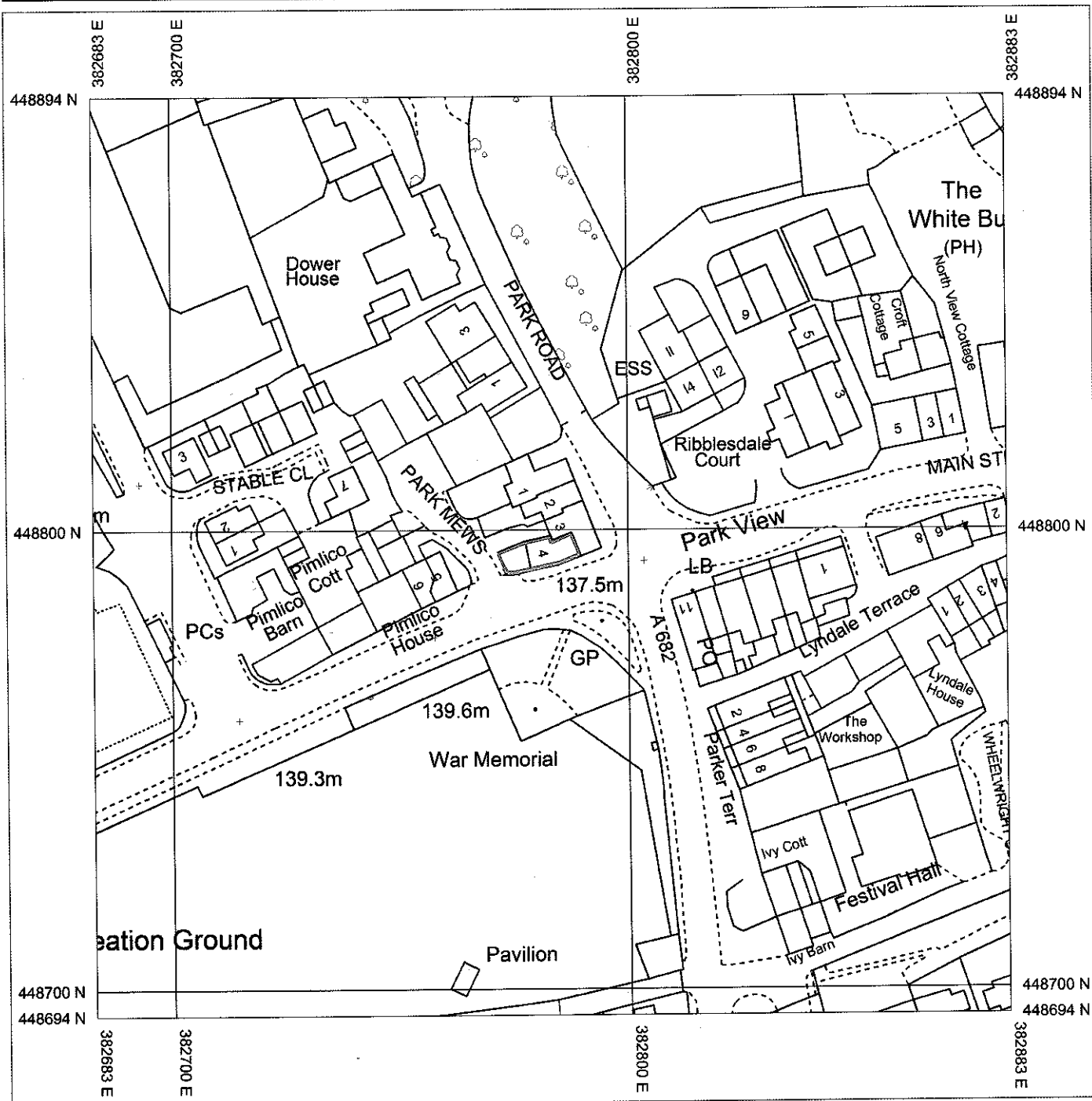

Location Map



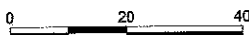

DESIGN AND ACCESS STATEMENT PRO-FORMA
