Morning Stephen,

From the plan the dimension of the forecourt area of the proposed dwelling will accommodate 2 vehicles however in order to avoid the likelihood of parked vehicles overhanging the footway I would require the footprint of the building to be set back a further 0.5 metres into the site.

I would also request that you attach the following note to any permission that may be granted;

This consent requires the construction/alteration of an access to the public highway. Under the Highways Act 1980 S184 the county Council as Highway Authority must specify and undertake the necessary highway works.
