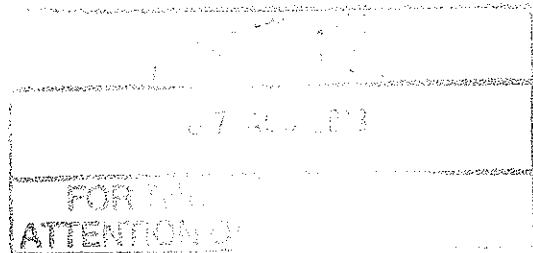
Dear Jane,
