1. Introduction

- 1.1 This Statement is intended to support the submission of Full Planning Permission to create a new dwelling to the land adjacent to 14 Church Raike, Chipping.
- 1.2 This Statement is intended to satisfy the requirements of the Planning Department as a Design and Access Statement and also provides an assessment of the planning context and explains why, in our opinion, the application ought to be approved.

2. Site Characteristics

- 2.1 The application site lies on the right hand side of the street when exiting the Village. The dwelling shall lie on the land between the new affordable homes and 14 Church Raike. The land that the affordable homes now lie on was previously in part ownership of our Clients.
- 2.2 Chipping is a small village within the Ribble Valley which benefits from some amenities and services. It lies around 10 miles west of Clitheroe town centre.
- 2.3 There is adequate infrastructure within Chipping to support this modest addition of one dwelling.

3. Application Proposal

- 3.1 This is a full planning application that seeks to secure consent for the erection of a single 4 bed dwelling.
- 3.2 The following adheres to the accepted format of the required Design and Access Statement and provides further information on the proposal.

3.3 <u>Use</u>

The site is currently vacant and is an eye-sore within the village.

3.4 Amount

The proposal is a four bed dwelling with living areas to suit. The dwelling shall include a double garage with storage above and adequate off street parking. The dwelling shall be surrounded by private curtilage for their use.

3.5 Layout

The scheme shall allow access from a location that currently exists for 12 and 14 Church Raike. The dwelling shall not overlook the dwellings surrounding it, nor shall it overlook those across the street. The design is sympathetic to the surrounding buildings.

3.6 Scale

The dwelling shall appear of a modest size from the main street and shall allow for adequate living space for the occupants.

3.7 Landscaping

There shall be alterations to the landscape by the means of a stone wall to the road side; this shall allow privacy for dwelling and occupants whilst they can enjoy the dwelling and the garden. There shall be paved areas, grassed areas and sections of flower beds as per the site layout plan.

3.8 Appearance

In terms of the impact on street scene the shall be the impact of an additional dwelling, however the property is designed in such a way that it is sympathetic to the agricultural feel of those dwellings of Church Raike. The continuation of random stone carries from existing dwellings on Church Raike and site well within the proposed site. The dwelling shall use natural materials.

3.9 Access

Access to the site is via the existing dropped curb off Church Raike, where numbers 12 and 14 Church Raike currently have access to the rear of their properties. This shall remain as per the site plan. The dwelling floor levels will provide access in accordance with Part M of the building regulations.

The location of the dwelling shall not be imposing on any other properties in the Village.

4 Assessment

- 4.1 This Application has been prepared following careful assessment with the local planning authority and with National, Regional and Local Plan Policies in mind. During pre-application discussions and as a result of the Council's processing of the previous planning application, it is apparent that the principle of the residential redevelopment of this site is acceptable in planning policy terms.
- 4.2 There are no protected species on site that may require protection.

5 Summary and Conclusions

- 5.1 Taking all of the issues surrounding the application into account, the applicant considered that this application will do justice to the existing surround and respects the rural character Chipping. The sensitive design ensures that the property will fit in with the surroundings as well as ensuring that its age can be differentiated.
- 5.2 There are no technical reasons why the application should not be granted and as set out above, the proposal is entirely consistent with national, regional and local planning policies. It follows that the application ought to be approved in accordance with current Planning Policy.
