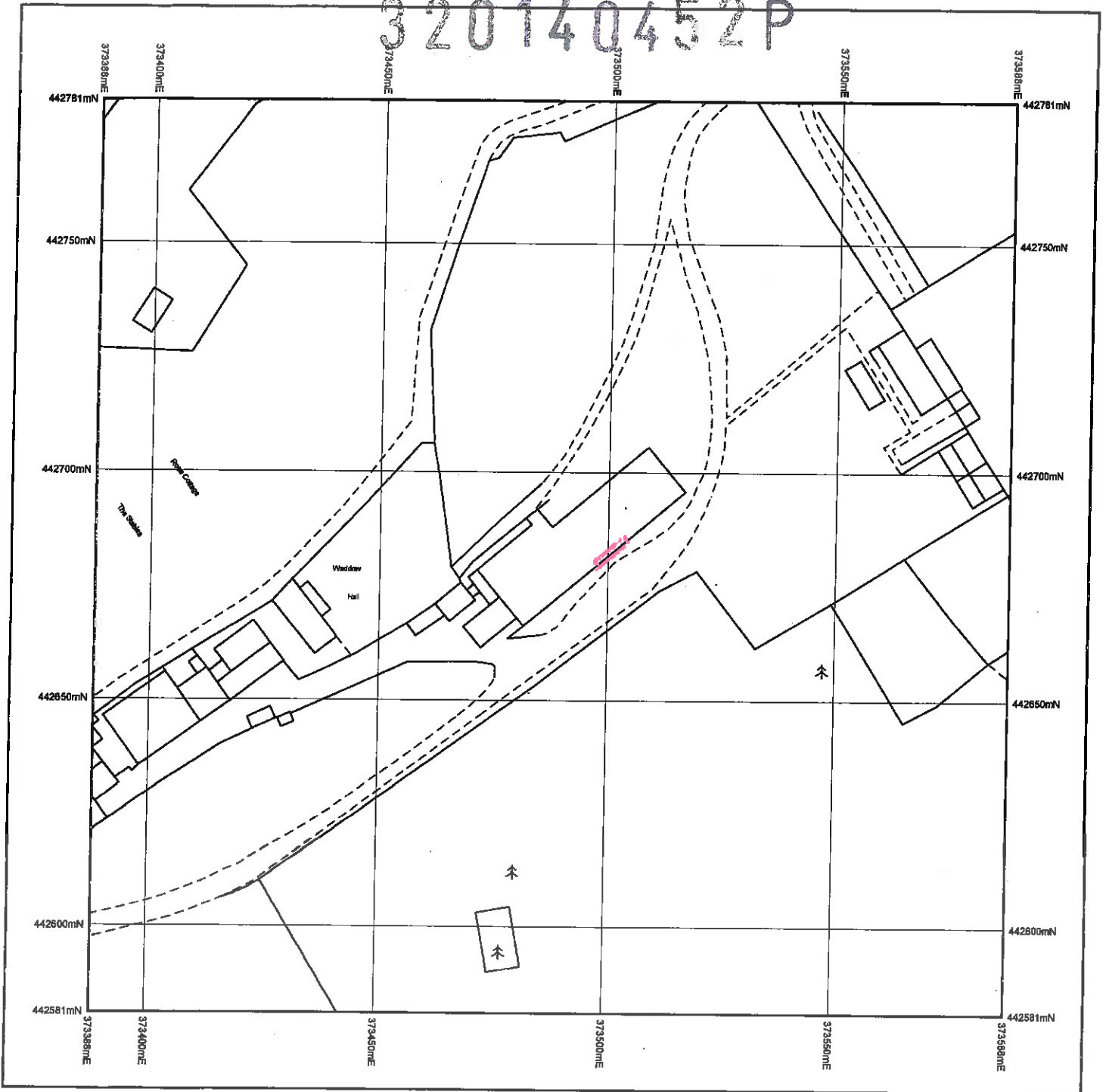

Heritage Statement: Waddow Hall

Proposed renovation works to Main Front Doorway Stonework

The inner Main Hall at Waddow dates back to the 16th century but the doorway is Georgian. Original internal and external features have been retained throughout the Hall. Unfortunately, the Front Entrance stonework at Waddow Hall has been severely weathered and eroded over a number of years.

The main pilasters and arch are in fairly reasonable condition, considering their age. However, the mouldings have been badly eroded and features are in danger of being lost.

Consulting Engineers Messrs Abbot and Lomax and our own Land Agents, John Pallisters, Chartered Surveyors, have stressed the need to undertake the renovation works as speedily as possible to preserve the heritage of the doorway. As a major feature of the Hall, it is necessary to undertake those repairs within the few months as there is now daily evidence of crumbling stonework and further damage caused by rainwater and weathering.

The Waddow Heritage Committee (volunteers) has obtained quotations to have the Georgian Doorway renovated by a reputable stonemason company. Their preferred provider is M & G Stone Limited.

M & G Stone Limited is a highly regarded stonework and masonry company, established 1985 in Keighley and with a portfolio of excellent stone and renovation work to their name. The company will conduct the following renovation; *please refer also to the attached photograph and notes.*

Plinths: The moulding to be re-created as original and cut back into existing stone (50mm).

The Capitols: Will be reproduced and dowelled onto the face of the existing stonework

Archway supports: The areas A, B and C on the attached photograph will be replaced and set back into external skin (100mm).

There will be total replacement of A, B and C and the Apex Arch-stone set into external skin (100mm).

All renovations will be sympathetic to the existing stonework and local stone and materials will be used throughout to restore the doorway to its former aspect.

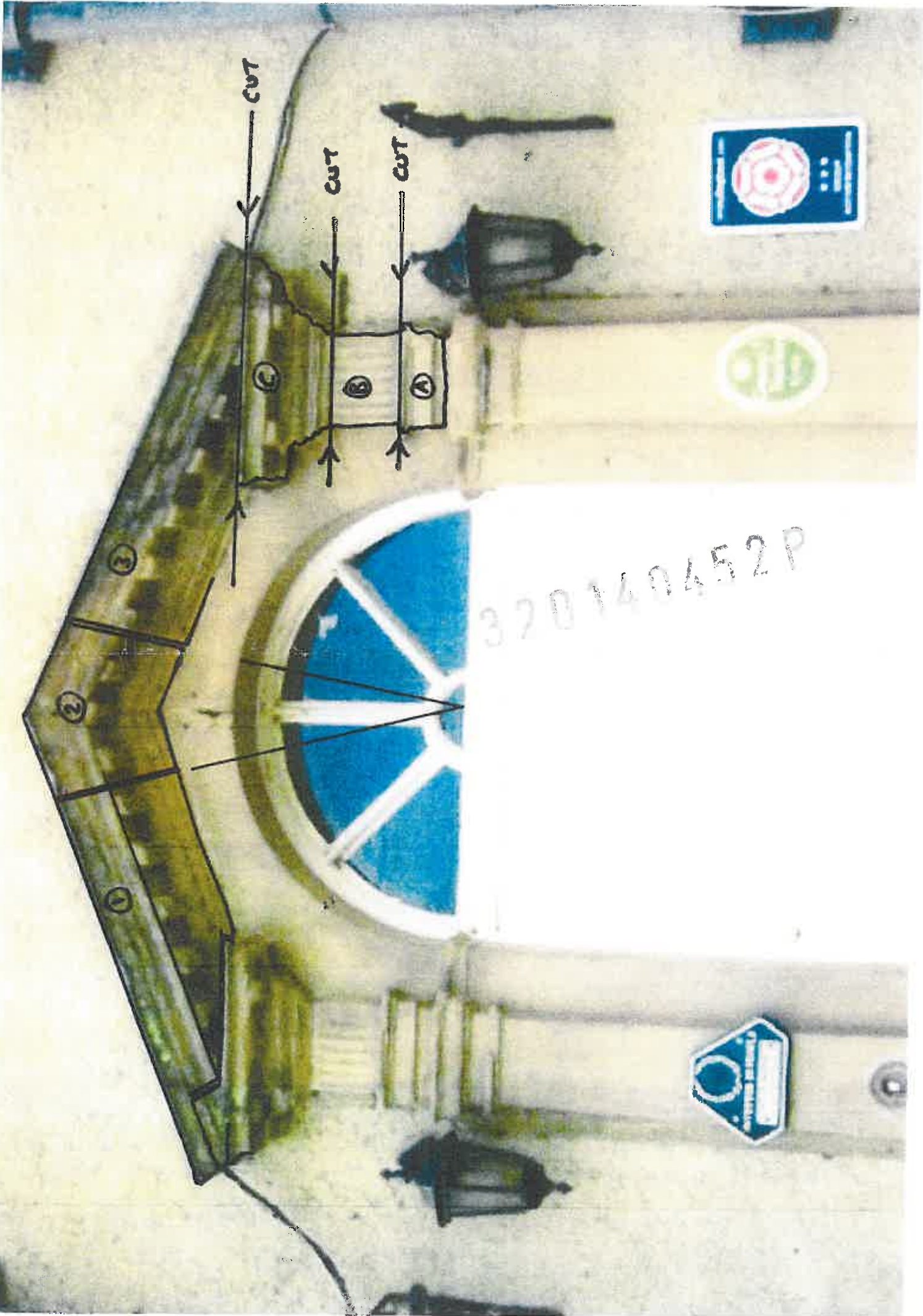

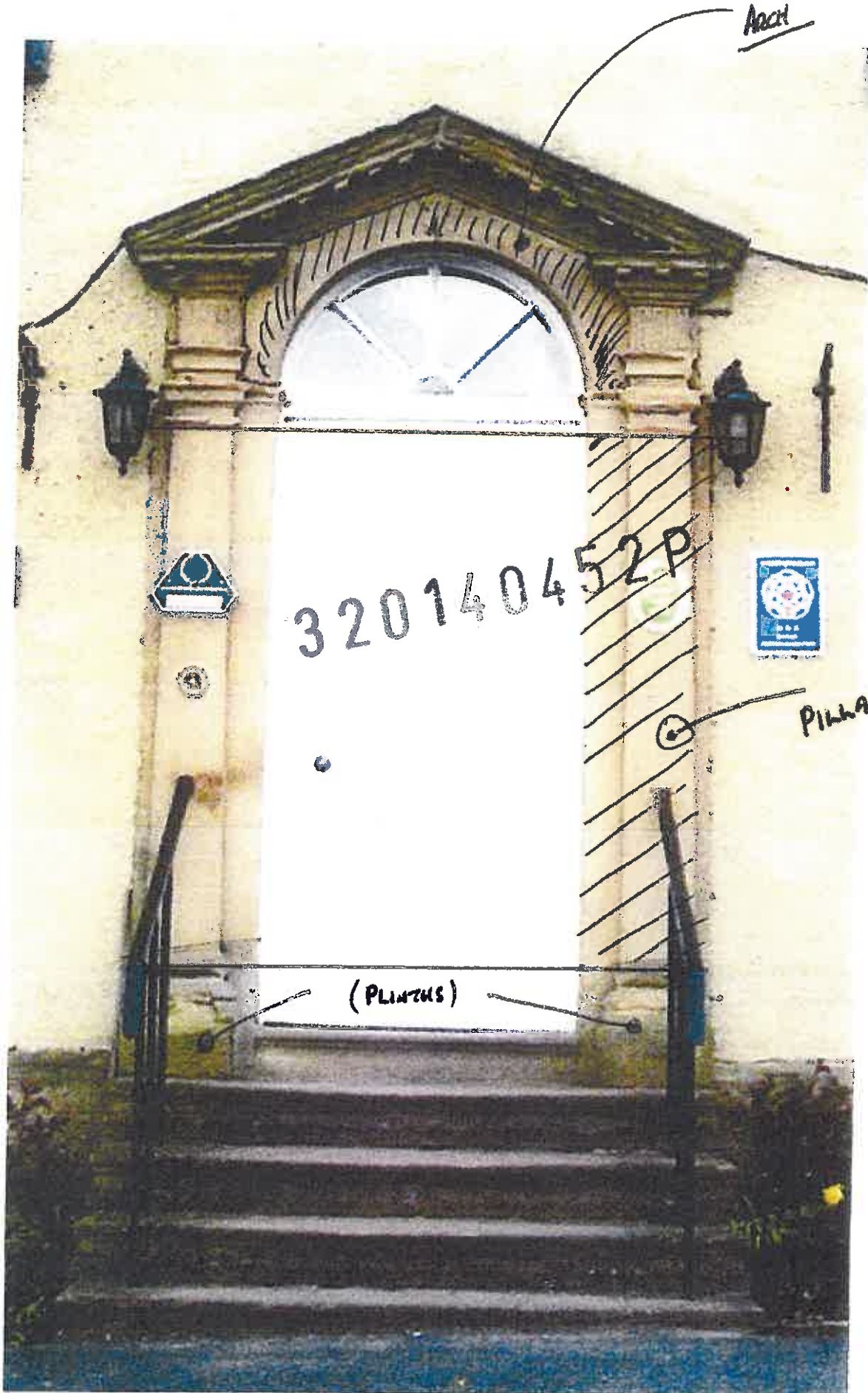
