Please note the following comments concerning the discharge of condition 6.

The Travel Plan submitted by Clitheroe Community Hospital meets the majority of Lancashire County Council's submission criteria for a Full Travel Plan. However one point needs to be addressed to make it fully acceptable and therefore discharge the condition, as follows.

Table 7.1 page 34 sets out the Travel Plans targets. The table lists 'Future Modal Split' targets but does not give a target date. We would recommend a 5 year timescale.

Please ask the developer to amend the travel plan. Once this is completed, I would have no further comment.
