Afternoon Claire,

I would have to express some reservations regarding this application . The proposal is for 2 x 2bed holiday cottages and whilst the parking standards for a 2 bed dwelling would suggest only 1 parking place being required , the 2 bedrooms may be occupied by an extended family arriving in 2 cars which would result in on street parking close to a crossroad junction which would not be acceptable. In addition the parking for the property fronting Higher Road is remote from the entrance which would increase the likelihood of parking taking place on the highway / verge.

Finally the proposal would utilise an existing field gate, if there is an alternative gate where is it? if not then I would need to know where it is to be located so I can assess the highway safety implications.

In respect of the application as submitted I would have to raise highway safety concerns and therefore recommend that the application be refused
