Please describe the proposed development including any change of use:

The proposed development of a new War Memorial in memory of 25 Flyers from various countries allied to the UK during WW2 who lost their lives in air crashes on the Fells of the Forest of Bowland during the War. The new memorial will take the form of a natural stone 'boulder', approximately 1250mm high x 2050mm wide by 400mm deep with an inset tablet of dressed stone engraved with the names of the flyers who were killed in these crashes. A gravel hardstanding area approximately 3 metres wide and 3 metres deep will be laid in front of the boulder, so visitors may stand in front of the memorial without getting their feet wet or muddy in order to read the names on the memorial. The site of the proposed memorial is immediately to the west of Trough Road and south of Langden Drive near Dunsop Bridge in the Forest of Bowland on open unfenced common land.
