Thank you for your consultation on the above planning application. A farmstead known as Coppy Lathe originally stood at the southern end of this site (OS 1:10,560 mapping sheet Yorkshire 166, published 1853 and surveyed 1849-50). This site has, however long been lost and modern aerial photography and mapping show no trace of any structures. As this part of the site appears to be excluded from the development in any case, we do not consider that any formal archaeological works are necessary.
