

GLOUCESTERSHIRE // DAVID TUCKEY DESIGN // GRADE II LISTED

Located in the Upper Oddington conservation area, Yew Tree house is a grade II listed building with single storey extension designed by award-winning practice, Jonathan Tuckey design.

The construction has a flat roof and floor-to-floor glazing which is a strong contrast to the historic stone house. Jonathan Tuckey Design describe this as “an acceptable approach and compliments the character of the original house whilst providing a statement that the extension is of the 21st Century.”



The scale of the extension pays due respect to the main house, whilst the light glazed appearance both expresses and enhances the historic mass and materiality.

“The facade delicately touches the existing house, allowing the stonework to flow seamlessly from outside. ... When illuminated at night, the original form of the building is visible and, during the daytime, the glass reflects the garden. This too reiterates the lightness of touch we have sought.” *David Tuckey Design*

YEW TREE HOUSE

GLOUCESTERSHIRE // WAUGH THISTLETON // MANSER MEDAL SHORTLISTED

Furzey Hall Farm is a high-profile extension to a Seventeenth Century Barn located in Filkins, Lechlade. Designed by Waugh Thistleton and shortlisted for the Manser Medal in 2010.

The project was widely covered, in particular by the Architects Journal: “Simple materials have been used confidently throughout ... stone walls left exposed ... The barn’s original character is juxtaposed with bold modern interventions ...



The owners achieved what they wanted while retaining the architectural integrity of some good rural buildings.” *architectsjournal.co.uk*

“The concept of the scheme is to highlight the old buildings and to create a hierarchy among the spaces. We will reuse the Cotswold stone where possible to retain a link between the two styles of building, however there will be a contrast in the form and atmosphere.” *Waugh Thistleton Architects*
