The Highway Development Control Section does not have any objections in principle to the proposed stable building with associated access improvements, providing the Facilities are for the property owner only.

The Highway Development Control Section recommends the following condition as part of the formal planning decision: -

Notwithstanding the provision of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) order 1987 paragraph 3(1) or any provision equivalent to this in any statutory instrument revoking and re-enacting this Order. The use of the stable, tack room and manege be restricted to domestic use only as applied for unless the prior consent of the local Planning Authority is obtained and commercial livery Equestrian events or other such use if prohibited. Reason: So that the Local Planning Authority can retail control over the impact of the development on residential amenity and/or highway safety.
