Planning Application 3/2016/0996: Discharge of condition(s) 11 (water wheel) and 3 (mortar mix) on planning permission 3/2014/0226; Land at Malt Kiln Brow, Chipping PR3 2GP

The above planning application includes a document entitled 'Kirk Mill, Chipping: Loft Boarding' which, according to the accompanying letter from HOW Planning LLP (20 October 2016) is intended to discharge Condition 11 on Listed Building consent 3/2014/0226.

Whilst we have no significant issues with the record of the loft boarding as supplied, it is difficult to see how the submission of this document could be considered as "Precise specifications of any works to the listed building's water wheel and its housing (including the removal of the historic fabric to provide views of the water wheel) ... " given that the loft in question is separated by an extant floor level from the water wheel and its housing.

We would therefore recommend that this condition is <u>not</u> discharged until full details of all relevant works have been submitted. These should include details of any proposed demolition or stripping works to the present walls and bridge across the wheel, the extant attached gears, etc. as well as construction works in these areas and any works of repair and refurbishment to the wheel itself.
