## **Clients Previous Discussions with Planning.**

The Client confirms the following discussions:

The applicant has pursued the pre-application method on the previous rejected scheme and it was noted to the council that no pre-application advice had been received prior to submitting the final planning application. This matter was even noted on the application.

A formal complaint was then sent to the council, which was ignored for many weeks. Eventually after escalating the non-response, many discussions took place between the applicant, John Macholc and Marshal Scott over this matter. The refusal and comments received were that a single dwelling would be favored/accepted. It was suggested that the applicant submit a suitable application to meet the original concerns and points for refusal and Marshal and John would review the application.
