Heritage Statement. 7/PR3 3JA

1. The statement concerns the placement of a wooden board to the elevation on Brewery Street.
 2. The wooden board will match other woodworks, painted white.
It is to be fixed to the gable as shown in the plan of the elevation.
 3. The board will draw the attention to often anxious patients to BLDS exact location and its services as they approach from market place. Many of these anxious patients are driving. Clearly there will be less distraction, easily locating BLDS. There will be a consequent reduction in potential road safety hazard.
 4. Being conscious of the Conservation Area since the 1980s, BLDS will undertake to maintain a "professional " and tasteful signage. Notice is drawn to some of the surrounding signage existing that falls far short of BLDS's proposal.
