Please see below comments from Longridge Town Council:

3/2017/0562 - The application is for an illuminated fascia sign to the shop front and a non-illuminated advertising board on the gable end at 1 Berry Lane, Longridge

LTC - Object to the application as the front sign is illuminated and the gable end sign is not in keeping with the area.

3/2017/0324 - The application is for a proposed extension to existing production building at Queens Mill, Chatburn Road, Longridge

LTC - No objection

3/2017/0620 The application is for a change of use of the existing RVBC Play Area to form a part single-storey, part-two storey extension to the rear of the existing medical centre at Berry Lane Medical Centre, Longridge

Following a long debate outlining in which it was stated that the land in question had been gifted to the people of Longridge for Recreational facilities together with Cllr Ashcroft's point that there was a need to increase health care facilities. Cllr Swarbrick didn't argue that there was a need for more health care but there were other ways of expanding other than using the land given to the young people of Longridge.
