plain stone surround, and 2 pitching holes under the eaves with plain stone surrounds.

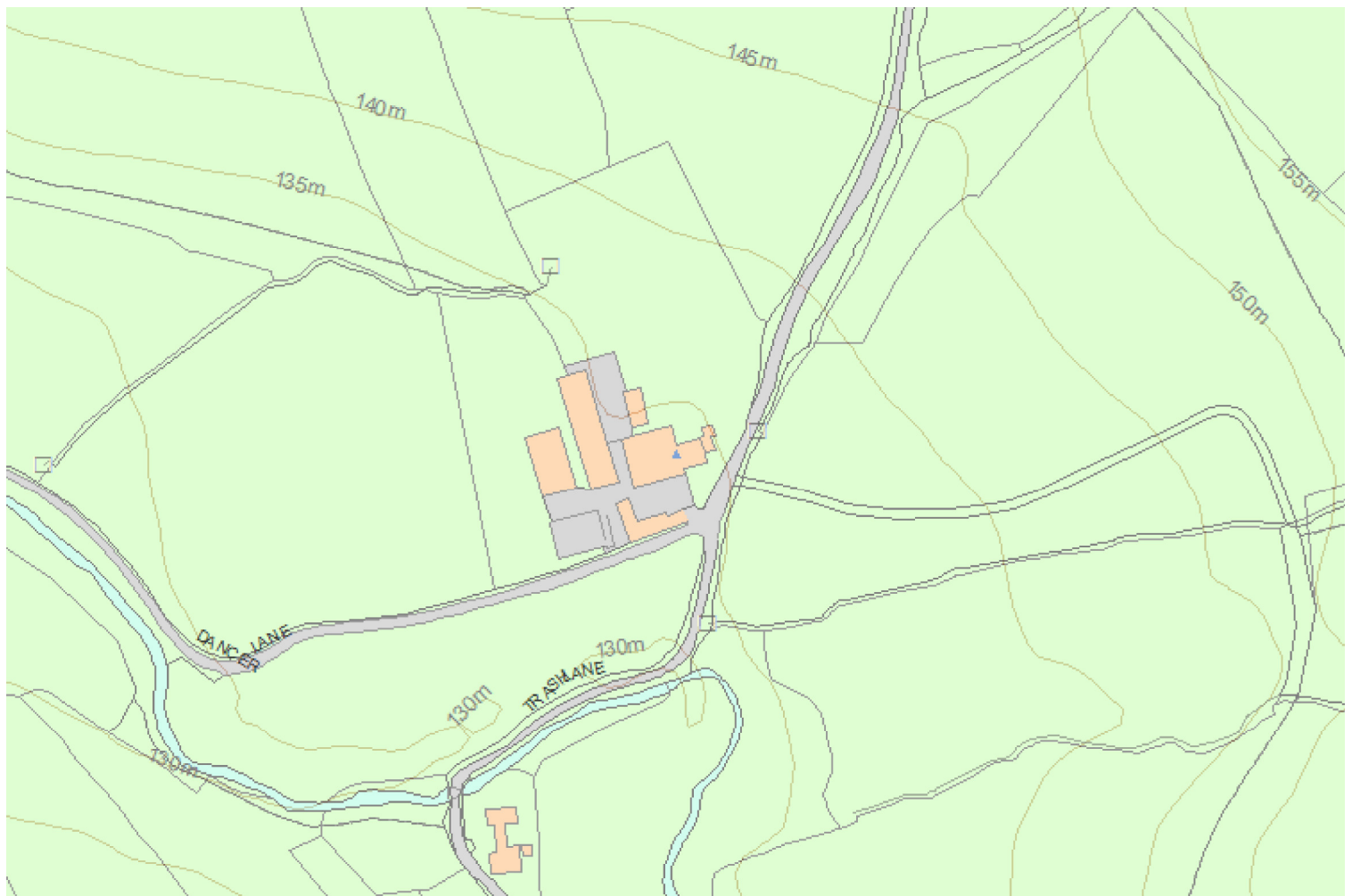
