The College have been encouraged to enter into a Heritage Partnership Agreement to define Consented Works, and to facilitate repairs without the need to constantly apply for Listed Building Consent.

Although the Document has not yet been formally signed, considerable information has been developed to determine the various procedures and define the scope of repair or renewal particularly in relation to the Timber Sash and Casement windows to 3 elevations of Shireburn Quad.

As such, Historic England have suggested that an Application for a Certificate of Lawfulness is made to the Local Authority to consent these works.

The works are identified in the Draft Heritage Partnership Agreement, which are to be consented under a Certificate of Lawfulness. the majority of the works are like for like repairs with the emphasis on retaining historic fabric. in some cases, new windows are proposed and here, the opportunity will be taken to replace the window to an agreed exemplar style thereby enhancing the asset. through the HPA, the works do not require Listed Building Consent, and the proposed repairs will not affect the character of the Listed Building.
