NOTES ON PLANTING

- 1 Topsoil in accordance with BS3882:2015. It shall be spread to min 450mm depth over planting beds and 150mm depth over turf areas and graded to fall.
- 2 Herbicide and Cultivation: Topsoil to be treated with an application of herbicide prior to planting, where necessary, strictly in accordance with the Control of Pesticides Regulations 1986 (or otherwise updated/superseded legislation), and following manufacturer's instructions by qualified staff. The topsoil shall then be cultivated to 150mm depth.
- 3 Container Grown Shrubs, Transplants and Whips: Shrubs and transplants shall comply with the National Plant Specification. Shrubs shall be planted in pits 300 x 300 x 200mm depth, and the backfill shall include 3 litres Peat Free Tree and Shrub Compost. Specimen plants to be planted in a pit 400 x 400 x 425mm depth with 5 litres Tree and Shrub Compost. All whips should be notched planted as required and healed into position.
- 4 Herbicide: Spot treat with herbicide throughout the maintenance period in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- 5 Bark Mulch: All Ornamental Planting beds to receive 75mm depth pulverised ornamental bark mulch.
- 6 Position of Plants: Final position of trees and shrubs subject to confirmation of service location and approval of statutory undertakers.
- 7 TREES - SELECTED STANDARDS: Tree pits for selected standards to be 600x600x600mm backfilled with good quality topsoil. Stakes to be 65mm diameter treated softwood driven firmly into the ground. Stakes to be 400mm above ground level and fixed to tree with suitable rubber tree tie.
- 8 TREES - HEAVY STANDARDS/EXTRA HEAVY STANDARD: Tree pit 1000x1000x600mm depth back filled with good quality topsoil. Stakes to be 100mm diameter treated softwood driven firmly into the ground. Stakes to be 600mm above ground level and fixed to tree with suitable rubber tree tie.
- 9 Watering: Plant only into moist soil and water thoroughly to the full depth of soil immediately after planting. Water regularly through the establishment period (minimum 3 months) to prevent dehydration.

Proposed Soft Landscape

- Existing Tree to be Retained
Trees to be retained and protected in line with BS5837:2012. Please refer to Arboricultural Method Statement and TPM Tree Survey Report and Drawing 2605 103.
- Existing Tree to be Removed
- Proposed Grass in Gardens
Grass within front and back gardens to be turf.
- Proposed Small Trees
Shrubs to be planted as 3L pots or 10-12cm girth Selected standards. Species include: Amelanchier lamarkii 'Toto', Ribes typhina. To be planted with single stake secured with a rubber tree tie.
- Proposed Ornamental Tree
Trees in soft landscaping to be planted as 14-16 cm girth Extra Heavy standards. Species include: Betula pendula, Malus 'John Downie'. To be planted with a double timber stakes secure with a rubber tree tie.
- Proposed Ornamental Shrub Beds
Beds to be planted with 3-5L shrubs at 3-5 per sq m and 10-15L specimen plants shrubs to be a mixture of structured evergreens and flowering specimens. Species include: Lavenula angustifolia 'Hokone', Hebe albertana 'Red Edge', Phlox 'Yellow Wave'.
- Proposed Low-Medium Formal Hedge
Low hedge to be planted at 60-80cm BK stock at 4 per sq m, and maintained at 60-80 cm high.
