Proposed childrens playground

At a representative meeting of Dinckley Parish Meeting on the 4th April the following observations were made:-

1. There is no objection of itself to a childrens playground adjacent to the camping pods.
2. However, a playground in the middle of a field in an agricultural and rural setting is incongruous. This is now a commercial development in a green field which used to be a dairy farm.
3. Views were expressed as to the bad visual impact the development will have. The pods themselves are visually intrusive and out of character but Planning permission has been granted and there is nothing we can do about it.
4. Parishioners are concerned that paragraphs 10,11 & 12 of the conditions are being ignored.
5. Car parking and site management need a lot to be desired and external lighting is in clear breach of conditions attached to the consent.
6. The fencing on the site is intrusive in a countryside setting.
