holes, one with plain stone surround. Above the smaller doors is re-set part of a triangular lintel inscribed 'ANNO DOMIN MD...'

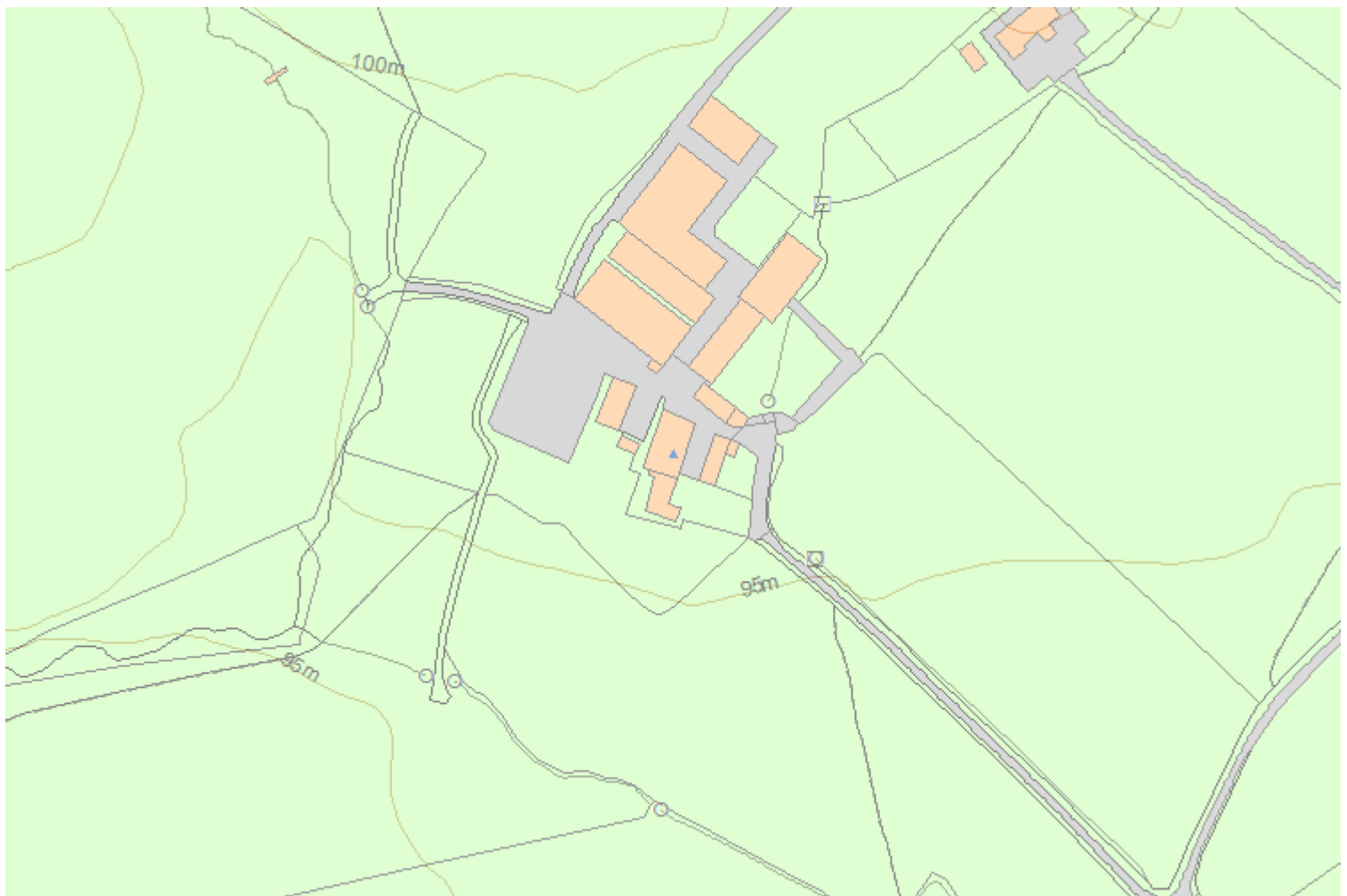
