This supporting statement is prepared on behalf of client's Mr & Mrs S. Wright of Blackhole Cottage in relation to the Approval (03/2017/0756) for Demolition of existing timber-clad stable building and replacement with one new holiday cottage.

The application is for an amendment for the holiday cottage to be occupied / used for a longer period of 180 days.

The current condition no. - 14 reads:-

"The holiday units hereby approved shall not be let to or occupied by any one person or group of persons for a combined total period exceeding 90 days in any one calendar year and in any event shall not be used as a unit of permanent accommodation or any individual(s) sole place of residence. A register of all occupants of the accommodation hereby approved shall be maintained at all times and shall be made available for inspection by the Local Planning Authority on request. For the avoidance of doubt the register shall contain the name and address of the principal occupier together with dates of occupation."

The original concept of the project has been based around country pursuits, ie; hunting fishing and shooting, combined with the adjacent stable / storage building.

As the seasons for which are longer than the 90 days allowed for occupancy,

- The hunting season lasting 5 months from 1st November through to March for the main season though cubbing (the training of young hounds) starts earlier in September.
- The shooting season lasting 5 ½ months,
