Thank you for your consultation on the above planning application. We have looked at the details on the council's web site. The wall in question provides a division at the end of burgage plot 42, as shown on Lang's map of 1766, and that boundary line may be of medieval origin, although the wall itself appears to be later. Looking at the photographs supplied with the application, however, would suggest that the material that it retains is simple garden soil. As such we do not consider that a formal archaeological response can be justified.
