Parking is already limited within the vicinity of the dwelling and I would require further clarification on the parking arrangements being set out for the proposal,

The dwelling is situated on a cul-de-sac within a turning head at the bottom of Green Park. There is already a number of cars which are being parked within the turning head and are also being parked on the footway.
