WPC objects to this application as the fence, which is already is situ, has an adverse affect on the neighbouring property's amenity in so far as the height of the fence overshadows the property thus taking away light from it; it also has an adverse visual impact on the residential area. The Council also wishes to comment that in parts, especially near the house and patio, the fence is significantly higher than the stated 2.5m above the ground level of no12.

The Council also believes that a business, which might adversely affect neighbours, is being run from the property and wondered if this needed to be the subject of a further planning application.
