Trees who's condition is moderate to poor and usually require a significant amount of tree surgery or be located in an area not readily accessible to the public
- Retention Category U**
Trees & shrubs which are dead dying or dangerous. Trees which are so damaged and diseased as to be incapable of further satisfactory development. Trees in this category should be removed.
