Feedback from Mr Greenwood dated 10th December 2018:
The principle of the extension and alteration of the property is acceptable. Should you wish to pursue the development as shown, it would ultimately be for the Council to assess and identify any potential harm arising from the proposal and whether this would be so significant as to warrant refusal.

However, I would recommend that further consideration is given to the design of the side extension and the scale of the ancillary outbuilding which I believe would result in a more appropriate and acceptable scheme. I would be happy to discuss these matters further prior to an application being submitted.
