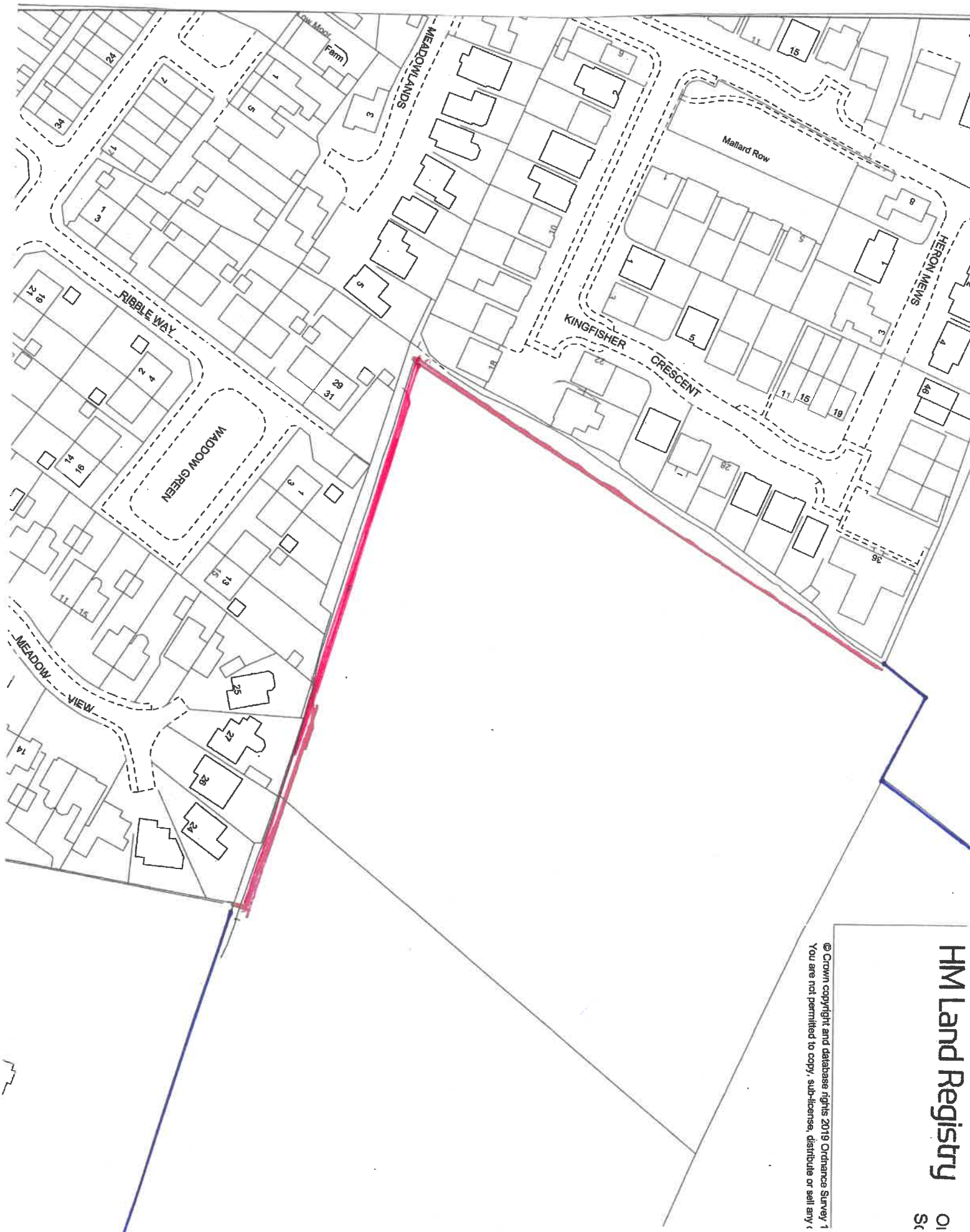

NOTE.

The land intended to be enclosed by the fence is let on licence to a local farmer who crops the grass three times a year for the production of silage to be used as the winter feed for his dairy herd.

Excessive trespass causes trampling of the grass making it difficult to cut and reduces output. Dog walkers also cause fouling by dog faeces which can result in pathogens being transferred to the milk from the cows and also damage to their health and can cause bovine diseases such as BSE and F and M.

The proposed fence, designed to discourage trespass will be 6 foot high and be comprised of chain link mesh topped by two strands of barbed wire.
