Thank you for the opportunity to respond to Planning application 3/2019/1103 – unfortunately the documents provided with the application do not enable Public Rights of Way to make an informed response right now.

Unfortunately the application documents and particularly the plan is not clear in terms of how the development should it be successful will affect. Public right of Way 3-1-FP6a (as attached) and amended documents show little if any meaningful detail of the likely impact of the development on the footpath concerned. In addition there is currently a temporary closure on the footpath that is unlikely to be reopened for some time due to serious sink holes under the footpath that would be a danger to the public — at this time without a full detailed account of what the development will entail we would raise an objection to this application.
