We have temporary planning permission for a 15m x 12m aluminium framed marquee with PVC walls and roof which has been granted until 31st May 2020, application number 3/2018/0260. I wish to reapply for planning permission for this same marquee in the same location. It is intended that the marquee will be replaced by a permanent building however as we are a charity funded business, this is dependant on fundraising which is not in place at this moment in time.

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6. Existing Use

Please describe the current use of the site

The marquee was erected in February 2017 as a temporary structure but then became an integral piece of infrastructure for supporting our growing number of events and day visitors. We therefore applied for pre-application advice which was given via Rachel Horton in December 2017 and temporary planning permission was granted in May 2018 for a period of 2 years. The marquee was purchased by a subsidiary group of Waddow Hall called the Friends of Waddow. This group is membership based, raising funds to purchase income-generating extras that the business cannot fund from its own budget. The group also acts as a volunteer support network for our events and the committee were keen to provide tangible support for our growing educational tourism market with suitable, cost-reducing infrastructure that had quickly become operationally essential. Total number of visitors during 2018 was - 24,736 and total numbers of visitors during 2019 was - 24,816 approximately 35% of those utilized the marquee in some way for dining or through large scale events and visits. It has allowed us to widen our offer, support higher numbers and has positively impacted on our ability to continue growing our educational tourism market, particularly with schools and events for girl guides. It is anticipated that a permanent structure will replace the marquee in the future, however as we are a charity business this project is fully reliant on fundraising the whole amount. Currently we do not have the funds to start such a project and the marquee is now an important financial and logistical facility to our business that we cannot afford to lose the use of whilst these funds are being raised.
