Chipping Parish Council are writing to comment on this planning application, as although not within our parish the transport of materials to/from the Park usually goes through our parish.

Whilst we are supporting of the proposal to erect 9 holiday lodges at the Wild Boar Park in support of tourism, we would like to make a condition of approval that the holiday lodges are erected on site and not made off site and transported to the Park. The reason for our "proviso" is the significant limitations of vehicles coming through our village because of historic buildings - most notably in Windy Street (single lane with reduced access at first/second floor height) and Talbot Street. This point has been backed by LCC Highways on a separate application by the Wild Boar Park.

The Parish Council would appreciate being kept informed of the developments with this application.
