Yes it will require a service occasionally to ensure it is in full working order same as the upvc and composite doors but the general life span of a upvc/composite door is approx 10 years before it may need replacing (this can vary depending on how much use it takes) where as the timber door will keep on going the look may need

Dear Miss Duckworth,

Following my recent visit to your property above and using the information you provided us with that the property is at risk from flooding. General note, the Environment Agency agree that 'While it's impossible to completely flood-proof a property, there are lots of things you can do to reduce the damage flooding can cause'. Flood protection is all about trying to prevent as much water as possible entering your property via doors, walls, floors etc, then if any water does get in it needs removing as soon as possible, keeping damage to a minimum. Ideally but not always possible it is best to keep water at the boundary by use of flood gates, barriers, walls etc. so with this in mind we have the pleasure in quoting for the manufacture, supply and fitting of the following:-

Front Door

like numbers 1, 2, 3
A bespoke timber flood resilient door made to look ~~like a solid door~~ (solid door with glazed ~~unit~~ unit in the top), the door will be made using Accoya (for more information on the benefits of using Accoya please see <http://www.accoya.com/about-accoya/benefits/>), the door will be supplied treated with 3 coats of Sikksens or 4 coats of paint (colour of your choice), the door will be fitted using heavy duty ironwork in a colour of your choice. The door is tested to 2ft (600mm) depth of water and is flood resilient every time it is locked. Please note that as this is a flood door they do have extra seals which does make the doors slightly harder to lock than a traditional door. As a general note we will always repair any damaged plaster work after removing the old frame but we will not re-decorate. Door spec as above but a 4 panel style door with the top 2 units clear glass, we will also need to replace the windows at both sides and 3 windows above the door, all double glazed units
