In the border between our house and our neighbours, we have eight leylandii and cypress trees which have grown to such a height that they are blocking the sunlight from both our and our neighbours gardens. There is also a multi trunk leylandii in our garden which is causing us similar problems. We have consulted John Gornall of Grimsargh who has recommended that 7 trees should be reduced by half and that two multi trucked trees should be removed completely.
