<p>NOISE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> To protect the amenity of neighbouring residents in respect of noise, the premises shall only open for business within the following hours: Mondays to Saturdays - 09:00 to 18:00 hours, and Not on Sundays/Bank Holidays. No more than one dog shall be permitted to be present in the dog grooming salon area at any time. Acoustic plasterboard to be fixed to the salon party walls with adjoining properties, as per the specification given in the noise assessment. 			
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
