I object to the proposal of demolishing the current houses on bridge terrace and replacing with 50+ new build houses. My objections are based on experience of living in Whalley to date - the roads are full to capacity, the village cannot handle more traffic and it does not need another new build housing estate. The village is at risk of becoming oversaturated and has not got the infrastructure to deal with this, or the geological impact of another estate. The houses already in existence are well made and represent history within the village.
