

Heritage statement

The following statement refers to the listed building Dilworth Brows Farmhouse (now known as The Brows Farm)

List entry number 1147429

National grid reference SD 62135 38393

The listing refers to the front façade of the building and includes T J 1839 oval 1st floor plaque. Pebbledashed rubble with slate roof. 2 storeys 2 bays. Façade has projecting quoins and stone gutter of square section. Windows sashed with glazing bars in plain stone surrounds. Door has plain stone surround. Chimney on left-hand gable.

None of the above will be affected in any way from the proposed agricultural building.

The proposed agricultural building is 25 meters from the listed building across agricultural land, its is adjacent to an existing agricultural building and is to be constructed in materials to match the existing agricultural building. It is not within the curtilage of the listed building and does not detract from it in any way.

The existing and proposed buildings are sympathetic to their surroundings with dark timber boarding to lessen their impact on the surroundings, they are situated off to the right of the listed building as you face it and so have no impact on the heritage assets.
