All trees are required to be removed to facilitate the installation of a drainage pipe to serve properties along Hayhurst Road, Grasscroft Way and Barley Close to stop their gardens from flooding.

Replacement tree planting is proposed to the north of the existing woodland to compensate for the loss of trees.
