Proposal: Regularisation of erection of 1.8m high garden fence to boundary

I have viewed the plans and submitted documents and I have the following comments to make:

The proposal

The proposal seeks regularisation of the erection of a 1.8m high garden fence to the boundary of the property and includes the creation of a further two off-street parking spaces. There have been no details provided for the new driveway and the local highway authority therefore requires details of the dimensions and materials used as well as visibility splays. The driveway will require a vehicular dropped crossing which will need to be installed by Lancashire County Council under section 184 of the Highways Act 1980.

I ask that more information is provided as requested above and that the plans are revised to reflect the rectification of the above raised highway concerns.

Failure to address the above concerns will result in an objection being raised from the local highway authority on highway safety grounds.

Note

 This consent requires the construction, improvement or alteration of an access to the public highway. Under the Highways Act 1980 Section 184 the County Council as Highway Authority must specify the works to be carried out. Only the Highway Authority can carry out these works and therefore
