Chipping Parish Council would like to comment on the latest application 2021/0240 for the Wild Boar Park to erect nine holiday lodges with associated parking and sewage facility, as well as Discharge Condition 6 the Construction Management Plan.

As with previous applications from the Wild Boar Park - we note that all construction of the lodges should happen at the site, but we have concerns as to the proposed routes by HGVs to the site. The maps provided by the applicant are poor, and as a Parish Council we would like to stress that it is not suitable to drive through the centre of our village via Windy Street onto Talbot Street (width - single lane, turning ability, as well as local residents parking, school children, walkers and cyclists). Should the application be approved, we would like a condition to be that the route through the centre of our village is not permitted.

Finally please can you advise if there has been any update on the outstanding application with the OTC for vehicle licences at this site.
